Burgess Matting & Surfacing Limited will, for a period of five years from the date of completion, offer a warranty against faulty workmanship and materials under normal use of the product.


The company would undertake to repair or replace the fault in question, after consultation with the client, at their discretion. This excludes normal wear and tear, vandalism or improper use of the product.
